San Joaquin County Food For You Commodity Food Program



San Joaquin County's Human Services Agency provides free food through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Emergency Food Assistance Program (EFAP).

What is the Food For You Commodity Food Program?

It is a program that provides free food to eligible residents in San Joaquin County.

How do I know if I am eligible?

Eligibility for the program is simple. A person (or household) must reside in the area where food is being distributed (ZIP Code) and they must meet established income guidelines.

Where can I get the food?

Currently, there are 15 commodity distribution sites throughout San Joaquin County that distribute food on **the third Thursday of every month** and 1 site that distributes food on **the last Wednesday of every month**. If you are eligible for the program just arrive at the location in your area (based upon ZIP Code) on the designated date and time. Food will be distributed during the posted hours or until all food has been given out.

Do I have to bring anything or sign anything?

Please bring your own bag or box. Also, you will be asked to present proof of residency (such as a PG&E Bill or a Driver's License). However, if you can't provide proof of residency, you are still able to receive food.

All recipients receiving food are required to sign the EFAP Certification of Eligibility form in which you declare that you are income eligible and reside in the area.
